CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

If you step into the Norm Waitt Sr. YMCA it is full of life! The Y is a vibrant community center focused on meeting the needs of Siouxland. After completing a market survey in 2019 the need for additional childcare was clear and that need as only grown over the last 4 years. The capital campaign represents an ambitious vision for our organization and the community. A 12,000 square foot Early Learning and Youth Development Center will included 4 childcare rooms, 2 flex rooms, and an indoor playground.



Rhonda Robson, CEO and Lauren Owens-Wehr, Donor Engagement and Development Director have been hard at work meeting with local businesses and individuals to campaign for financial support. To date, the pair has raised nearly \$2,850,000 of the \$5,000,000 needed to complete the Early Learning and Youth Development Center. The goal is to break ground this fall. The project will take approximately 14 months to complete.
