As we near the end of the first quarter of 2024, I want to acknowledge the accomplishments of our organization over the past year.

For over 135 years, the Norm Waitt Sr. YMCA has been committed to promoting Healthy Living, Youth Development, and Social Responsibility. The Y plays a significant role as the leading nonprofit to strengthen the foundations of each community served, both locally and nationally.

## 2023 YMCA Accomplishments:

- Made a positive Impact on 25,328 Individuals in our community.
- Hired a dedicated Wellness Director to ensure quality programs for our members and guests.
- Invested \$250,000+ in Facility Improvements
  - A few projects included: a new pool pump, repaired/repainted lines/refinished the gym floor, a new HVAC Unit, a fence on the riverfront of the Y, and NEW LED parking lot lights.
- Started our NEW Early Learning Center | Infants & Toddlers
