POSITION SUMMARY:

The **Lifeguard** plays a vital role in advancing the YMCA's mission of strengthening community by connecting people to their potential, purpose, and one another. This position is responsible for maintaining a safe, supervised aquatic environment that prevents accidents, responds to emergencies, and promotes confidence in and around the water. Guided by the YMCA's core values—**Caring, Honesty, Respect, and Responsibility**—we foster a culture that is **Welcoming, Genuine, Hopeful, Nurturing, and Determined**.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Create a welcoming environment.
- 2. Deliver high-quality service aligned with departmental standards and YMCA goals.
- 3. Ensure physical and emotional safety of all participants, staff, and members.
- 4. Build positive relationships with peers, participants, and families through respectful and consistent communication.
- Maintain clean, safe, and organized program/work environments; promptly report any concerns or incidents.
- 6. Attend and actively participate in required trainings, meetings, and organizational events.
- 7. Uphold YMCA policies and represent the organization with professionalism, integrity, and respect.
- 8. Model YMCA core values and use the Y-Voice: Welcoming, Hopeful, Determined, Genuine, and Nurturing.
- 9. Perform other duties as assigned in support of the YMCA's mission and strategic goals.

- Must maintain certification-level physical and mental readiness.
- Demonstrated ability to perform all lifeguard skills to YMCA standards.

- Work indoors and outdoors in varied weather conditions.
- Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.
